The Settlement Class Period as defined in Paragraph 27 of the Class Action Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) includes any insurance claim falling within the definition of the Class (in Paragraph 3 of the Agreement) with a date of loss occurring on or after the date set forth below, provided that the date of loss does not occur after the date of the Preliminary Approval Order. If the time period for Statutory Period Claims states “Not Available,” a Class Member whose Insured Structure is in that jurisdiction may not make a Statutory Period Claim.

The specific Quantum, Homesaver, Legacy and Business Insurance forms referenced below are identified as such on Exhibit H to the Class Action Settlement Agreement.
