ORDER MODIFYING DEADLINES
FOR PROPOSED CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

The parties have advised the Court that the Settlement Administrator is ready to proceed with issuing the e-mail and mailed notices to the potential class members by April 13, 2020. Accordingly, the deadlines set forth in the Court’s Order dated February 4, 2020 (“Preliminary Approval Order,” Docket Entry No. 48) are hereby modified as follows:

a. The Settlement Administrator will e-mail the Settlement E-mail Notice and mail the Settlement Cover Letter and Settlement Long-form Notice to the Potential Class Members on or before **Monday, April 13, 2020**.

b. Settlement Class Counsel shall file any papers in support of their requested award of attorneys’ fees and expenses and the Settlement Class Representatives’ Incentive Award on or before **Tuesday, April 28, 2020**.

c. Opt-out requests and objections must be postmarked no later than **Wednesday, May 13, 2020**. Claim forms must be postmarked no later than **Thursday, May 28, 2020**.

d. The Settlement Administrator will file a declaration of compliance regarding completion of the notice, and the number and names of opt outs, on or before **Friday, June 12, 2020**.

e. The Parties will file a motion for Final Approval and supporting documents thereto and respond to objections on or before **Friday, June 12, 2020**.

f. The final approval hearing will be rescheduled for June 23, 2020, at 2:00pm [a.m./p.m] in Courtroom 11-A, 11th floor of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, James A. Byrne U.S. Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106. If the emergency associated with COVID-19 continues into June of 2020, the Court may decide to hold the final approval hearing by telephone, in which event a telephone number and access code will be made available on the Court's docket and the website maintained by the Settlement Administrator.

All other provisions in the Preliminary Approval Order remain in effect.
